1.4.6. A summary of the complaints received from authorized ICANN-Accredited Registrars regarding the processing of Phase 3 registrations

Received a compliant that a registrar-hold transaction is not yet available. This has been subsequently corrected.

Received a complaint from the registrar that several domain names do not appear in the zone file. The problem was identified as incorrect configuration of the system (stronger than required verification set in the system) and promptly corrected.

1.4.7. A description of significant technical difficulties encountered during Phase 3

During the Phase 3 the registry and most registrars implemented a new functionality allowing to request Aviation Community Membership IDs (eligibility decision) through a standardised transaction in the registry system. This was the single most important development in the registry and required testing and intensive interaction between the registry and registrars to set the new system working.

Although no particular technical difficulties were encountered on the registry side, it is apparent that introduction of registration restrictions (restricted choice of names and eligibility verification) is a new area for both the registry and registrars and presents registrars with new challenge how to best offer the registration services in a top level domain with relatively complex eligibility and name restriction rules.
